The story of the Hospices de Beaune begins in 1443 under the leadership of Chancellor Nicolas Rolin. Today, the reputation of the Hospices de Beaune, its vineyards and its auction is international.

Since the 1950s, the PATRIARCHE Wine Company has contributed to the development and success of the auction, buying about 1/3 of the auction ! In 2011, Patriarche continued the tradition by buying barrels from prestigious parcels.

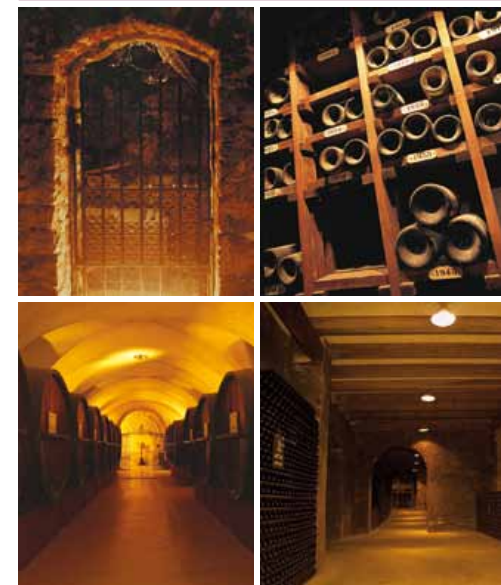

Tradition ... and Passion of a world-minded Lady.

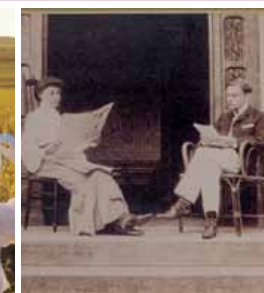

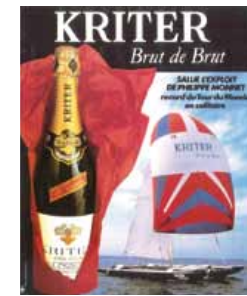
