Makeup : 90% Chardonnay. From Pays d'Oc, harvested on shaly soils, terraced vineyards and pebbly or limestone soils. These grapes provide the richness and power typical of these wines. The remaining 10% consists of Chardonnay grapes from petite Champagne vintages growing on clay and limestone soils. These grapes give the wine its steeliness and freshness.

Exclusively matured in stainless steel tanks to express all the freshness and character of the fruit.
